- Ratification & Implementation Launch

NUG Development Process

– Consensus Development Conference

- Request your organization to send a representative to NUG Consensus Development Conference (NTIMC covers travel expenses)
- Nov. 28-Dec. 1, 2006– Irvine, CA



NUG Development Process

–Finalization

- Post-conference – Steering Committee will finalize NUG
- Request your organization to be represented on Steering Committee to assure all final language is acceptable



NUG Development Process

–Ratification & Launch Event

- Public / Media Event – early / mid 2007
- Top Leadership from each organization to participate
- Joint effort by all Coalition members to publicize NUG launch
